THE FATS, CHEESE AND TEA (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a), shall be amended by substituting in the table in the Schedule thereto, which specifies the amount of the ration, for the entries relating to butter, margarine, cooking fats and cheese, the entries set forth in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1951, and shall come into force on the 9th day of September, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order reduces from 4 oz. to 2 oz. the amount of butter which may be obtained against appropriate coupons in a General Ration Book R.B.1 and a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 relating to the week beginning 16th September, 1951, and to alternate weeks thereafter.

The amount of butter obtainable against appropriate coupons in a Temporary Ration Card R.B.12 is reduced from 4 oz. to 3 oz. per week as from 9th September, 1951.

It also reduces from 2 oz. to 1½ oz. the amount of cheese which may be obtained against appropriate coupons in a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 and a Temporary Ration Card R.B.12 as from 9th September, 1951.
