THE BACON (PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (NO. 2)
(AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Bacon (Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) Order, 1950 (a) as amended (b), shall be further amended -

(a) by substituting in the First Schedule thereto for the entry relating to Whole Ulster Rolls (including Long Clears) the following entry:-

"Ulster Rolls (including Long Clears) -

(b) by substituting in the Second Schedule thereto for the entry relating to Prime Collar (unsmoked and smoked) the following entry -

	Smoked.	2	10 $\frac{1}{2}$

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Bacon (Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 23rd day of September, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order further amends The Bacon (Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) Order, 1950, by -

- (1) reducing the fixed wholesale prices of whole ulster rolls by four shillings per cwt.; and
- (2) increasing the maximum retail prices of collar bacon by 2d. per lb.
