THE FLOUR CONFECTIONERY (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF
GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Flour Confectionery (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a) shall be amended as follows:-
 - (1) by inserting after paragraph 3 of Part III of the Schedule thereto the following paragraph:-

"3A. On a sale, on or after the 25th November, 1951, and not later than the 29th December, 1951, of a cake which is wholly covered on the top or on the top and sides with any one or more of the following substances, namely, sugar icing, almond marzipan and chocolate, and which is substantially decorated, and which is packed singly in a non-returnable cardboard container supplied by the seller, a sum not exceeding the actual and reasonable cost of the container to the seller may be added to the maximum price."; and
 - (2) by substituting in paragraph 4 of Part III of the Schedule thereto for the words "paragraphs 2 or 3" the words "paragraphs 2, 3 or 3A."
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Flour Confectionery (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 25th day of November, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order provides that, from the 25th November until the 29th December, 1951, a sum not exceeding the cost of the container may be added to the maximum price of a prescribed type of cake sold singly in a non-returnable cardboard container.
