

THE MEAT (RATIONING) (BAILEWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 9) ORDER, 1951.

REVOKED SEE S.I. 115 (1952)

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a) as amended (b), shall be further amended by substituting for the Schedule thereto, which specifies the amount of the meat ration, the Schedule to this Order.
2. For the avoidance of doubt, the maximum quantity of meat which may be obtained or supplied against an appropriate coupon for meat relating to the week beginning 14th October, 1951 and valid for use during the said week and the following week, but not used during the said week beginning 14th October, 1951, shall be the maximum retail price applicable in relation thereto immediately prior to the coming into operation of this Order.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
4. The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1951, dated 21st July, 1951 (c), and The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 8) Order, 1951, dated 4th October, 1951 (d), are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention of The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, as amended thereby.
5. This Order may be cited as The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 9) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 21st day of October, 1951.

THE SCHEDULE.

Amount of the Meat Ration.

1. Amount against the appropriate coupons relating to each week in a -

General Ration Book R.B.1. Form R.B.12.	}	1s. 8d. maximum price (10d. maximum retail price for each coupon), or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey, 3s. 0d. maximum price (1s. 6d. maximum retail price for each coupon).

2. Amount against each appropriate coupon in a -

Child's Ration Book R.B.2. Ration Book R.B.7. Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A.	}	10d. maximum retail price, or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey 1s. 6d. maximum retail price.

3. Amount against the appropriate coupons in a Weekly Seaman's Ration Book R.B.6 -

- (a) being coupons through which a hole has been punched. } 40 ozs. net (20 ozs. net for each coupon).
- (b) not being coupons through which a hole has been punched. } 75 ozs. net (37½ ozs. net for each coupon).

4. Amount against an appropriate coupon on a form R.G.44. } 1s. 10d. maximum retail price.

5. Where a form R.G.48 relating to meat is produced with a ration document the amount obtainable during the period of validity of such form against the appropriate coupon(s) relating to each week shall be increased as specified on that form.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This amending Order reduces, as from 21st October, 1951, the amount of the meat ration which may be obtained against appropriate coupons in Ration Books R.B.1 and Forms R.B.12 from 1s. 11d. to 1s. 8d. maximum retail price, or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey from 3s. 2d. to 3s. 0d. maximum retail price. The value of appropriate coupons in the Child's Ration Book R.B.2, Ration Book R.B.7 and Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A is reduced from 11d. to 10d., or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey from 1s. 7d. to 1s. 6d. maximum retail price.

Coupons valid for use in the week beginning 14th October, 1951, and the following week but not used in the week beginning 14th October, 1951, will be valid if used in the week beginning 21st October, 1951, for the maximum retail price applicable thereto immediately prior to this Order coming into operation.
