THE GENERAL FOOD (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 6) ORDER, 1951.

REVOKED by S.I. 129 (1952)

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended as follows:-
 - (1) by substituting for Part I of the Schedule thereto, the Schedule to this Order.
 - (2) by substituting in Part II of the said Schedule for the maximum retail price of "1s. 4½d." in relation to Full Cream Unsweetened (Evaporated Milk) (other than New Zealand) the maximum retail price of "1s. 5d."
 - (3) by substituting in Part III of the said Schedule for the maximum retail price of "1s. 0½d." in relation to Dried Plums or Prunes (other than Prunes canned in Syrup), the maximum retail price of "1s. 10½d."
 - (4) by substituting in Part X of the said Schedule for the maximum retail price of "2s. 4d." in relation to Processed Cheese and any other variety of Cheese to which The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, applies, the maximum retail price of "2s. 0d."
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1951, dated 11th August, 1951 (c) is hereby revoked.
4. This Order may be cited as The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 6) Order, 1951, and shall come into force on the 12th day of November, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order -

- (a) prescribes maximum retail prices for 16 oz. and 20 oz. cans of Imported Canned Fruit;
- (b) increases the maximum retail price of Full Cream Unsweetened (Evaporated Milk) (other than New Zealand);
- (c) increases the maximum retail price of Dried Plums or Prunes (other than Prunes canned in syrup);
- (d) reduces the maximum retail price of Processed Cheese and any other variety of Cheese to which The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailliwick of Guernsey) Order, 1951, applies.
