

THE GENERAL APPAREL (DISTRIBUTORS' MAXIMUM PRICES)
(BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1951.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The General Apparel (Distributors' Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (a) as amended (b) shall have effect subject to the following amendments:-

- (1) to paragraph (1) of Article 1 thereof, there shall be added the following definition:-

"cash margin" in relation to the sale of any hand-knitting yarn of any quantity by an importer or a retailer means -

- (a) where he was selling similar hand-knitting yarn in the period 16th July, 1951 to 15th August, 1951, an amount equal to the appropriate percentage specified in the Second Schedule hereto -
- (i) where he is an importer selling imported hand-knitting yarn, of the landed cost of similar hand-knitting yarn of that quantity sold by him in that period;
- (ii) where he is a retailer, of the purchase price paid or agreed to be paid by the first purchaser being a retailer, for similar hand-knitting yarn of that quantity sold by him in that period;
- (b) in any other case, an amount equal to the appropriate percentage specified in the Second Schedule hereto -
- (i) where he is an importer, of the landed cost of that hand-knitting yarn;
- (ii) where he is a retailer, of the purchase price paid or agreed to be paid by the first purchaser, being a retailer, for that hand-knitting yarn."

- (2) for paragraph (b) of Article 2 thereof, there shall be substituted the following paragraph:-

"(b) (i) in the case of hand-knitting yarn, the cash margin;

(ii) in any other case the appropriate percentage of such purchase price specified in Column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto."

- (3) for paragraph (b) of Article 3 thereof, there shall be substituted the following paragraph:-

"(b) (i) in the case of hand-knitting yarn, the cash margin;

(ii) in any other case the appropriate percentage of such landed cost specified in Column 3 of the Second Schedule hereto;" and

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The General Apparel (Distributors' Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 10th day of December, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends The General Apparel (Distributors' Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, as amended.

The importer's and retailer's maximum price of hand-knitting yarn which is similar to hand-knitting yarn sold by him in the period 16th July to 15th August, 1951, is now to be computed by adding to the landed cost or purchase price, as the case may be, the cash margin which he was permitted to add in that period to the landed cost or purchase price of similar yarn. If he did not sell similar hand-knitting yarn in that period the maximum price is to be computed as heretofore by adding to the landed cost or purchase price the appropriate percentage specified in the Second Schedule.
