THE BREAD (CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF
GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 5) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Bread (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1948, as amended, shall be further amended by substituting in Column 2 of the Second Schedule thereto for the maximum prices of "2½d. per loaf" and "at the rate of 2½d. per 14 oz." the maximum prices of "3d. per loaf" and "at the rate of 3d. per 14 oz." respectively.
2. This Order may be cited as The Bread (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 5) Order, 1949, and shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1950.
