THE RATIONING (PERSONAL POINTS) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

- S.I. 100 (1949).
1. The Rationing (Personal Points) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, shall be amended as follows:-
 - (a) by substituting in Articles 2, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 19 thereof for the words "ration period" wherever they occur the words "8 week period";
 - (b) by substituting in proviso (c) to Article 2 thereof for the words "not exceeding 1 cwt." the words "not exceeding 2 cwt.";
 - (c) by substituting in Article 20 thereof for the words "ration period No. 5 and of each ration period thereafter" the words "each 8 week period";
 - (d) by substituting in paragraph 1 of Part II of the Fourth Schedule thereto for the words "in any ration period shall not exceed 5 per cent" the words "in any 8 week period shall not exceed 10 per cent".
 2. This Order may be cited as The Rationing (Personal Points) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order makes alterations to The Rationing (Personal Points) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, whereby, as from 1st January, 1950, personal points rationing shall operate on an 8 week period basis in relation to personal points foods supplied or obtained otherwise than for household consumption.
