THE FOOD (POINTS RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT
NO. 6) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Food (Points Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:-

(a) by adding to paragraph (1) of Article 1 thereof the following definition:-

"'16 week period' means the period of sixteen weeks beginning on the 1st day of January, 1950, and each succeeding period of sixteen weeks thereafter.";

(b) by substituting in Articles 8, 9 (2), 11 (2) and 13 thereof for the words "ration period" wherever they occur the words "8 week period";

(c) by substituting in paragraph (1) of Article 9 thereof for the words "8 week period" wherever they occur the words "16 week period";

(d) by substituting for paragraph (1) of Article 11 thereof the following paragraph:-

"(1) Every person who has a points banking account in respect of an establishment shall deliver to the Committee at the address where the account is kept, or at such other place as the Committee may specify -

(a) during the ninth week of each 16 week period all account slips which have been received by him from his suppliers and not previously surrendered to the Committee, together with a deposit slip (to be obtained from the Committee) relating to that 16 week period, Part C of which has been completed so far as is necessary to show particulars of such account slips;

(b) during the first week of the 16 week period beginning 1st January, 1950, a deposit slip (to be obtained from the Committee) relating to the immediately preceding 8 week period, and during the first week in each 16 week period thereafter a deposit slip relating to the immediately preceding 16 week period, duly completed in accordance with the instructions thereon, together with all account slips which have been received by him from his suppliers in respect of any period prior to the period then current and not previously surrendered to the Committee.";

(e) by deleting from the item relating to canned pork or pork brawn in Column 1 of Section A of Part 1 of the Second Schedule thereto the words "or pork brawn";

- (f) by substituting in Column 2 of the said Section A for the points value "32 per pound" in relation to luncheon meat, pork loaf and meat lunch the points value "16 per pound", and for the points value "16 per pound" in relation to ham loaf, veal loaf, canned veal and ham, canned veal and ham loaf, meat roll or galantine, jellied or stuffed jellied veal or pork, jellied pork and veal, jellied beef, pressed veal, pressed pork and beef and pressed pork and veal the points value "8 per pound";
- (g) by substituting for Section B of Part I of the said Schedule the Section B set forth in the Schedule to this Order;
- (h) by substituting in Part II of the said Schedule for the entries relating to crab and to crawfish (crayfish) the following entries:-

- (i) by deleting from Part II of the said Schedule the entries relating to snoek and mackerel;
- (j) by deleting from Part IV of the said Schedule the entry relating to canned tomatoes;
- (k) by substituting in Column 3 of Part V of the said Schedule for the points value "4" in relation to special full cream sweetened condensed milk the points value "1" and for the points values "2" in relation to full cream sweetened and machine skimmed sweetened condensed milk the points values "1";
- (l) by substituting in Column 3 of Part XI of the said Schedule, relating to shredded suet, for the points values "6", "12", "81", "162", "324" and "12 per pound" the points values "4", "8", "54", "108", "216" and "8 per pound" respectively;
- (m) by substituting in Column 3 of Part XII of the said Schedule for the points values "150" for a 7 lb. container of table jelly crystals and "22 per pound" for any other container, the points values "120" and "18 per pound" respectively.

2. This Order may be cited as The Food (Points Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 6) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1950.

THE SCHEDULE.

Section B - Other Meat and Meat Products.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order -

- (a) frees from points rationing canned pork brawn, canned boneless chicken or turkey, canned sausage meat (including pork sausage meat or pork sausage bulk), canned meat puddings (including cottage pie), canned meat hash (including corned beef hash), canned Irish stew, ready or prepared meals, home produced or imported, including any ready or prepared meal in a container labelled or embossed "Meat and Vegetables" or "M and V", canned rabbit, canned sausages in brine, spaghetti and sausages in tomato sauce, vegetable and macaroni casserole with pork in tomato sauce, snock, canned mackerel and canned tomatoes;
- (b) reduces the points values of luncheon meat, pork loaf, meat lunch, ham loaf, veal loaf, canned veal and ham, canned veal and ham loaf, meat roll or galantine, jellied or stuffed jellied veal or pork, jellied pork and veal, jellied beef, pressed veal, pressed pork and beef, pressed pork and veal, crab, crawfish (crayfish) sweetened varieties of canned condensed milk, shredded suet and certain packs of table jelly crystals;
- (c) makes alterations in The Food (Points Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, whereby, as from 1st January, 1950, the points rationing scheme shall operate, in relation to points rationed foods supplied or obtained otherwise than for household consumption, on an 8 week period basis (16 week period basis in the case of establishments).
