THE RATIONING (PERSONAL POINTS) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

- S. I. 40 (1949).

1. The Rationing (Personal Points) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended by substituting for the First Schedule thereto, which specifies the number of points represented by an appropriate coupon, the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as The Rationing (Personal Points) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 29th day of January, 1950.
