THE UTILITY CLOTH AND UTILITY HOUSEHOLD TEXTILES (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

- S.I. 86 (1949)
1. The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall have effect subject to the following amendments:-

(a) for Article 1 there shall be substituted the following Article:-

"1. The maximum price to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer in respect of new utility goods shall be -

(1) in the case of cloth of a description contained in Column 1 of the Fourth Schedule hereto, the appropriate amount specified in Column 2 of that Schedule;

(2) in the case of cloth (including lace and woven curtain net) to which paragraph (1) of this Article does not apply and household textiles (other than bedding) (hereinafter called "goods"), the aggregate of the following amounts:-

(a) the purchase price paid or agreed to be paid to the manufacturer or to the wholesaler, by the first purchaser (being a retailer);

(b) an amount equal to the appropriate percentage of such price specified in Column 2 of the First Schedule hereto; and

(c) an amount equal to $2\frac{1}{2}$ per cent of the aggregate of the foregoing amounts;

Provided that in respect of goods described in Column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, the maximum prices of goods of a description specified in Column 1 of the appropriate Part of the relevant Related Schedule shall not exceed the appropriate amount specified in Column 3 of such Related Schedule with the addition of $2\frac{1}{2}$ per cent of such amount.

(b) in paragraph (2) of Article 4 after the words "First Schedule hereto" there shall be inserted the words "or in the Fourth Schedule hereto";

(c) in the Second Schedule, for the reference to Related Schedule No. 5G and Supplement No. 1 thereto there shall be substituted a reference to Related Schedule No. 5G and Supplements Nos. 1 and 2 thereto; and

(d) after the Third Schedule there shall be added as the Fourth Schedule to that Order the Schedule to this Order.

2. This Order may be cited as The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 28th day of January, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends the Order which fixes retailers' maximum prices for utility cloth and utility household textiles by introducing new maximum prices for utility quilt cloths. Maximum prices for these cloths are now specified in the Fourth Schedule to the Principal Order and are no longer to be computed by reference to the price paid and the permitted margins.
