Revocation Order

SPENT

THE CONTROL OF LIGHTING (GUERNSEY) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

- S.I. 139.*
1. The Control of Lighting (Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated 3rd December, 1949, and the General Licence dated 6th December, 1949, issued ~~thereunder~~ *S.I. 140.* are hereby revoked.
 2. This Order may be cited as The Control of Lighting (Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1950, and shall come into force on the 20th February, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order revokes The Control of Lighting (Guernsey) Order, 1949, and the General Licence dated 6th December, 1949, issued thereunder, which prohibited the use of lighting or the illumination of premises or hoardings at certain times except under licence issued by the States' Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities.
