THE GENERAL FOOD (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 7) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey, excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended by substituting for Part XI (Flour) thereof, the Part so numbered in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 6) Order, 1949, dated 27th December, 1949, is hereby revoked.
3. This Order may be cited as The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 7) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 27th day of February, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends the Principal Order to provide separate maximum prices for imported and locally packed plain and self-raising flour. The maximum price of imported self-raising flour is increased by ½d. per 3 lb. packet and the maximum price of locally packed self-raising flour by ¼d. for 1½ lb. packets. The maximum price of 3 lb. packets of National flour and self-raising flour, locally packed, remain unchanged.
