THE POULTRY (CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Poultry (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated 1st July, 1949, The Poultry (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1949, dated 25th July, 1949, and The Poultry (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1949, dated 22nd November, 1949, are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof. *-S.I. 23 (49).*
2. This Order may be cited as The Poultry (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 9th day of March, 1950. *-S.I. 56 (49).*
