The States Dairy Committee as Competent Authority in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Cairney) Regulations, 1945, by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Provisions (Transitional Provisions) Order in Council, 1946, and pursuant to Section of the States of Deliberation of the 29th March, 1950, fixing the prices of milk during the period 1st April, 1950 to 31st March, 1951, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The price payable by the States Dairy Committee (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") in respect of clean, whole, locally produced cows' milk delivered by the producer to a milk depot or to such other place as may be directed by the Committee shall be as follows:-

and, however, that the above prices may be varied from time to time at the discretion of the Committee provided that an average price of 2/1¹/₂d. per cwt is not exceeded throughout the course of this year.

2. The price to be paid by a retailer to the Committee as regards whole milk shall be at the rate of 1/3¹/₂d. per cwt.

3. The price to be paid by consumers to retailers as regards whole milk, whether produced locally or imported and whether delivered at the residence of the consumer or fetched by the consumer, shall be at the rate of 6¹/₂d. per pint.

4. This Order may be cited as The Milk Prices (Cairney) Order, 1950, and shall have effect from the 1st day of April, 1950.
