THE CATERING ESTABLISHMENTS (ICE CREAM) (REVOCATION)
ORDER, 1950.

SPENT

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Catering Establishments (Ice Cream) Order, 1947, dated 25th August, 1947, is hereby revoked.
 2. This Order may be cited as The Catering Establishments (Ice Cream) (Revocation) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 29th day of March, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order removes the restriction imposed on the 27th August, 1947, on the use of whole milk (including dried whole milk, condensed milk and evaporated milk) in the manufacture of ice cream in, by or for a catering establishment or institution.
