THE EGGS (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. In this Order -

"Buy" includes offer or agree to buy and "sell" includes offer or agree to sell or expose for sale;

"Cooking eggs" means eggs which have been imported as cooking eggs;

"Eggs" means the eggs in shell of domestic fowls and domestic ducks;

"Home produced eggs" means eggs produced in the United Kingdom;

"Imported eggs" means eggs which have been imported into the Bailiwick of Guernsey from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man and the Channel Islands.

2. No person shall sell or buy any eggs of a description appearing in the Schedule to this Order at a price exceeding the maximum price applicable thereto in accordance with the provisions of the said Schedule.

3. The Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated 5th - 1699 March, 1949, The Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) - 1623 Order, 1949, dated 1st April, 1949, The Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1949, dated 26th May, 1949, and The Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, - S.I. 44 1949, dated 20th August, 1949, are hereby revoked.

4. This Order may be cited as The Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 and shall come into operation on the 23rd day of March, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order, which supersedes The Eggs (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, reduces the maximum prices of all grades of home-produced and imported eggs (other than eggs imported direct from France) by 6d. per dozen. The maximum price of eggs imported direct from France remains unchanged at 4/- per dozen.
