Tomato Store Packing - 1950.

Registration of Growers.

The States Committee for Horticulture, under and by virtue of The Export of Tomatoes Law, 1949, as extended by the Export of Tomatoes Law, 1949, (Continuance) Law, 1949, for the purpose of ensuring the orderly and expeditious marketing of tomatoes from Guernsey in 1950 hereby orders:-

All growers who intend to have their tomatoes packed by a store packer are required to insert in the Form below details of the store packer whom they wish to engage for the 1950 tomato export season.

Growers wishing to utilise the services of a store packer will have to register with one store packer only for the whole crop from any one vinery.
