THE UTILITY CLOTH AND UTILITY HOUSEHOLD TEXTILES (MAXIMUM PRICES)
(BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 5) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

- S.I. 86 -

1. The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall have effect subject to the following amendments:-
 - (a) in Part I of the First Schedule for the reference in item 10 to Related Schedule No. 5G there shall be substituted a reference to Related Schedule No. 5H;
 - (b) in the Second Schedule for the reference to Related Schedule No. 5G and Supplements Nos. 1, 2 and 3 thereto, there shall be substituted a reference to Related Schedule No. 5H and for the reference to Related Schedule No. 6N there shall be substituted a reference to Related Schedule No. 6N and Supplement No. 1 thereto; and
 - (c) for the Fourth Schedule to that Order there shall be substituted the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 5) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 29th day of March, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, which fixes retailers' maximum prices for utility cloth and utility household textiles by -

- (a) fixing increased maximum prices for the four descriptions of utility cotton quilt cloths included in the Fourth Schedule to the principal Order;
- (b) fixing new maximum prices for the six descriptions of utility rayon quilt cloths now added to that Schedule; maximum prices for these cloths are no longer to be computed by reference to the price paid and the permitted margins;
- (c) bringing into force Related Schedule No. 5H to replace Related Schedule No. 5G and Supplements Nos. 1, 2 and 3 thereto (utility household textiles); and
- (d) bringing into force Supplement No. 1 to Related Schedule No. 6N (utility upholstery cloth and utility curtain cloth).

The Related Schedules set out overriding maximum prices for the goods to which they relate.
