GENERAL LICENCE DATED 6TH APRIL, 1950, MADE BY THE STATES
OF GUERNSEY COMMITTEE FOR THE CONTROL OF ESSENTIAL
COMMODITIES UNDER THE FOOD RATIONING (GENERAL
PROVISIONS) (BAILLICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949.

1. The States of Guernsey Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities in pursuance of Articles 28 and 30 of The Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, -1642 1949, as amended, hereby authorises any trader to supply and any consumer to purchase, free of rationing restrictions, during the period ending on the 22nd April, 1950, Robbins Toffees and Jelly Cubes, which were imported into the Island, free of rationing restrictions.
2. This Licence shall come into force on the 8th April, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Licence authorises the sale during the period ending 22nd April, 1950, of Robbins Toffees and Jelly Cubes "off points" provided the stocks were imported into the Island free from rationing restrictions.
