



ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE.

Traffic Regulation (Number 2 of 1950).

The Island Police Committee, acting under the powers conferred on them by the Traffic Regulations Ordinance, 1950, hereby give notice that the Traffic Regulation made by them which came into force on the 11th day of April, 1950, is hereby amended as follows :

For the paragraph numbered 7 therein, there shall on the 28th day of April, 1950, be substituted a new paragraph numbered 7, in the following terms ...

"Hauteville and Cornet Street, St. Peter Port, from the junction of Pedvin Street to the Picquet House, otherwise than from south to north"

EXPLANATORY NOTE:

The existing Regulation is hereby amended so that Hauteville down to the junction of Pedvin Street is no longer confined to one-way traffic.
