THE SUGAR (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT)  
ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Sugar (Rationing) <sup>№ 4 of 1950.</sup> (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, shall be amended as follows:-
- (a) by inserting in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (8) of Article 5 thereof (which paragraph relates to the validity of appropriate coupons for sugar marked "R" and "Quarter R") after the words and figure "coupons numbered 9" the word and figure "or 13";
  - (b) by adding at the end of sub-paragraph (b) of the said paragraph (8) the words and figure "or No. 13";
  - (c) by adding at the end of sub-paragraph (c) of the said paragraph (8) the words and figures "or the period from the 23rd April, 1950 to 20th May, 1950, inclusive".
2. This Order may be cited as The Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 23rd day of April, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order enables holders of Ration Books R.B.1, R.B.2, R.B.4, Duty Ration Cards R.B.8R and Temporary Ration Cards R.B.12 to obtain an additional 1 lb. of sugar during the four week ration period beginning 23rd April, 1950.
