THE FOOD (POINTS RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT
NO. 8) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

- 1647 B.
1. The Food (Points Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:-
 - (a) by deleting from paragraph (1) of Article 1 thereof the definition of seaman's condensed milk coupon;
 - (b) by deleting from the proviso to paragraph (1) of Article 2 thereof paragraph (b) of that proviso;
 - (c) by deleting from the definition of "authorised quantity" in paragraph (1) of Article 1 thereof and from Article 4 thereof and from paragraph (1) of Article 5 thereof the words "other than a seaman's condensed milk coupon" wherever they appear;
 - (d) by deleting paragraph (2) of Article 5 thereof and paragraph (4) of Article 10 thereof;
 - (e) by substituting for the First Schedule thereto the Schedule to this Order;
 - (f) by deleting from the Second Schedule thereto Parts I, IV, V and X thereof relating to meat and meat products, canned vegetables, canned condensed milk and shredded suet;
 - (g) by substituting in Column 3 of Part XI of the said Second Schedule, relating to table jellies, for the points values "6", "6", "6", "180" and "27 per pound" the points values "4", "4", "4", "120" and "18 per pound" respectively;
 - (h) by deleting the Third Schedule thereto.
 2. This Order may be cited as The Food (Points Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 8) Order, 1950, and shall come into force on the 23rd day of April, 1950.

THE SCHEDULE.

<u>Appropriate Coupons.</u>	<u>Number of Points.</u>
1. A coupon in a page headed "Points" in a General Ration Book R.B.1, Junior Ration Book R.B.4, Child's Ration Book R.B.2 or Points Coupon Book R.G.28P, or a similar coupon affixed by or on behalf of the Committee to a Form R.B.12:-	
(a) Marked "A".	1
(b) Marked "B".	1
(c) Marked "C".	2
2. A coupon marked "Points" in a Form R.B.12 or a Duty Ration Card R.B.8R.	4
3. A coupon marked "K", "KK" or "Points" in a Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A.	2
4. A coupon marked "Points" in a Weekly Seaman's Ration Book R.B.6.	14
5. A coupon marked either "Bacon" or "Meat" with a stamp endorsed thereon by or on behalf of the Committee, and forming part of a Weekly Seaman's Ration Book R.B.6 which has been endorsed by or on behalf of the British Ministry of Transport with the words "Non-European Diet".	50

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order -

- (a) reduces from 24 to 16 per four weeks the number of points available to the holder of a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Junior Ration Book R.B.4 or a Child's Ration Book R.B.2. The value of each points coupon in a Form R.B.12 or a Duty Ration Card R.B.8R is reduced from 6 to 4 points and in a Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A from 3 to 2 points. The value of other points coupons remains unchanged;
- (b) frees all meat and meat products, canned beans, all varieties of canned milk and shredded suet from the provisions of the Order;
- (c) reduces the points values of table jellies.
