THE EXPORT OF TOMATOES (ZONING) ORDER.

The States Committee for Horticulture, in pursuance of paragraph 5 of "The Export of Tomatoes (1950) No. 2 Order" (a) hereby order:-

1. For the purposes of this Order, the Island is divided into two zones as follows:-

NORTHERN ZONE.

From the Grand Bouet, Vranguc, Ramée, Longue Rue, turn left into the Landes du Marché as far as the Chapel, turn right along Charruée Road, then Carteret Road to the coast. All glasshouse properties on the right hand side and to the north of these roads will be in the Northern Zone.

SOUTHERN ZONE.

All properties to the south of the above mentioned roads will be in the Southern Zone.

2. For the week ending 20th May, tomatoes will be shipped as follows:-

TUESDAY, May 16th. Tomatoes packed in both zones will be shipped on this day.

THURSDAY, May 18th. Tomatoes packed in the Northern zone will be shipped on this day.

FRIDAY, May 19th. Tomatoes packed in the Southern zone will be shipped on this day.

SATURDAY, May 20th. Tomatoes packed in the Northern zone will be shipped on this day.

3. The Shipping days for the zones from Thursday May 18th until further notice are therefore as follows:-

Northern Zone - Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

Southern Zone - Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

4. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order, Packers may, by arrangement with the Guernsey Tomato Shipping Board, be given facilities for shipping a proportion of their produce each day of the week.
