THE MEAT (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Meat (Maximum Retail Prices) ⁻¹⁶²⁹ (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, shall be amended as follows:-

(1) by substituting in Article 1 thereof for the definition of "Home Killed" the following definition:-

"Home-Killed" as respects any meat means meat other than locally produced pork derived from livestock slaughtered in Great Britain, Northern Ireland, Eire, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man."

(2) by adding in Article 1 thereof after the definition of "Imported" the following definition:-

"Locally produced Pork" means pork derived from pigs slaughtered in the Bailiwick of Guernsey."

(3) by substituting for Part IV of the Schedule thereto, the Part so numbered in the Schedule to this Order.

2. This Order may be cited as The Meat (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1950, and shall come into force on the 15th day of May, 1950.
