 LOI RELATIVE AU PORYPHORE - 1933.

Colorado Beetle (No. 2.) Order, 1950.

Under and by virtue of the powers conferred on them by Article 3 of the Loi Relative au Poryphore (angliof Colorado Beetle), 1933, the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries hereby orders as follows:-

1. No person shall remove seaweed from any of the beaches or foreshores around the Islands of Guernsey Herm or Jethou unless such seaweed has been burnt prior to its removal from the beach or foreshore from which it has been gathered.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This order may be cited as the Colorado Beetle (No. 2) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 17th day, 1950.
