THE MILK (CONTROL AND RATIONING) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1947.
AMENDMENT NO. 6 ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, the President of the States' Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities and the States Dairy Committee, hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Milk (Control and Rationing) (Guernsey) Order, 1947, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:-

(a) by substituting for Article 4 thereof, the following Article:-

"4. (1) Notwithstanding any provisions of this Order to the contrary the owner of cattle may retain milk for household consumption in his household or for supply by way of gift or for household consumption in the household of a farm hand employed by him.

(2) Where the ownership of cattle is vested in more than one person or in a limited liability Company each of such persons or the shareholders of the Company shall be entitled to retain milk as provided in paragraph (1) of this Article."

(b) by substituting for Article 16 thereof, the following Article:-

"16. Notwithstanding any provisions of this Order to the contrary, the feeding of milk to calves is permissible."

3. This Order may be cited as The Milk (Control and Rationing) (Guernsey) Order, 1947, Amendment No. 6 Order, 1950, and shall come into force on the 9th day of March, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order further amends The Milk (Control and Rationing) (Guernsey) Order, 1947, to enable owners of cattle to retain milk for household consumption in their household or for supply by way of gift or for household consumption in the household of a farm hand employed by them, special provisions being made in cases where the ownership of cattle is vested in more than one person or in a limited liability Company. The Order also removes the restriction on the quantity of milk which may be fed to calves.
