IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946.

The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949,
Amendment No. 2 Order, 1950.

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

- (1) There shall be deleted from the First Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated 3rd August, 1949, (a) the following item:-
"Linseed Oil". *S.I. 45 of 1949*
- (2) The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 1 Order, 1949, dated the 11th day of October, 1949, (b) and the Delegation of Power to grant Import licences (No. 2) Order, 1949, dated the 11th day of October, 1949, (c), are hereby revoked. *S.I. 95 of 1949*
S.I. 96 of 1949
- (3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
- (4) This Order shall come into force on the 25th day of May, 1950, and may be cited as "The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 2 Order, 1950".
