ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE.

Traffic Regulation (Number 3 of 1950).

The Island Police Committee, acting under the powers conferred on them by the Traffic Regulations Ordinance, 1950, hereby give notice that the Traffic Regulation made by them, which came into force on the 11th day of April, 1950, is hereby amended as follows :-

As from Saturday, 3rd June, 1950, paragraphs 4, 5 and 8 are deleted.

George Street. The driving or riding of any vehicle in that street in the direction from South-East to North-West is again prohibited.

EXPLANATORY NOTE :

With reference to paragraphs 4, 5 and 8 this amendment means that Vauvert, Victoria Road and Castle Emplacement will again be open to Two-Way Traffic, and George Street will again be confined to One-Way Traffic.
