THE MOTOR FUEL (CONTROL) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Motor Fuel (Control) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, shall have effect subject to the following amendments:-

(1) by adding at the end of sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph (1) of Article 1, the following proviso:-

"Provided that nothing in this sub-paragraph shall restrict a supply being furnished wholesale to a dealer if the coupons surrendered (being coupons which authorised supply by that dealer on the date on which they were surrendered to him) cover the amount of the wholesale supply less an allowance of one and one half per centum, and are delivered by the dealer with such information inserted thereon by him as is required to be so furnished."

(2) In Article 10 -

(i) the following sub-paragraph shall be substituted for sub-paragraph (a):-

"(a) a Standard ration coupon relating to the month of May, nineteen hundred and fifty or any earlier month, one half of a gallon and one quarter of a gallon respectively."

(ii) sub-paragraph (b) shall be deleted;

(3) In paragraph (1) of Article 11 -

(i) in sub-paragraph (b) the word "and" shall be deleted;

(ii) in sub-paragraph (c) there shall be added at the end the words "; and";

(iii) the following sub-paragraph shall be inserted after the said sub-paragraph (c):-

"(d) in the case of a coupon relating to any month in the rationing period beginning on the first day of June in any year the period (if any) between the issue thereof and the said first day of June."

2. This Order may be cited as The Motor Fuel (Control) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1950, and shall come into force on the 22nd day of May, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends The Motor Fuel (Control) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, by -

- (1) Making provisions for the supply of petrol wholesale to a dealer on the surrender of coupons against which the dealer has previously supplied petrol;
- (2) Increasing the coupon-free allowance to dealers for working losses from 1 per cent to $1\frac{1}{2}$ per cent;
- (3) Increasing the value of a unit for every standard ration coupon relating to any month after May, 1950, to one gallon;
- (4) Enabling holders of standard ration coupons for the rationing period June - November in any year to obtain motor fuel against them before the beginning of the rationing period.
