THE IMPORTED WARE POTATOES (MAXIMUM PRICES) (GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

- S.I. 104 of 1949.
1. The Imported Ware Potatoes (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1949 (a) shall be amended by substituting in Article 2 for the words "price exceeding 2½d. per lb." the words "price exceeding 2d. per lb."
 2. This Order may be cited as The Imported Ware Potatoes (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 5th day of June, 1950.
