GENERAL LICENCE DATED 4th MAY, 1950, MADE BY THE STATES OF GUERNSEY COMMITTEE FOR THE CONTROL OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES UNDER THE MILK (CONTROL AND RATIONING) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1947.

The States of Guernsey Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities in pursuance of Article 27 of The Milk (Control and Rationing) (Guernsey) Order, 1947, as amended, hereby issues the following Licence:-

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of The Milk (Control and Rationing) (Guernsey) Order, 1947, as amended, the States Dairy and retailers may supply milk to any manufacturer for use by him in the preparation or manufacture of food, and any manufacturer may obtain milk for use as aforesaid. ⁻¹³¹⁴
2. In this Licence -
"food" means biscuits, bread, buns, pastries, cakes, rolls, scones and other similar articles, ice-cream, soft cheese and curd cheese, sweetmeats (including sugar confectionery and chocolate) and synthetic cream.
3. This Licence shall come into operation on the 5th May, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Licence permits the States Dairy and retailers to supply milk to any manufacturer for use by him in the preparation or manufacture of the following foods:-

Biscuits, bread, buns, pastries, cakes, rolls, scones and other similar articles, ice-cream, soft cheese and curd cheese, sweetmeats (including sugar confectionery and chocolate) and synthetic cream.
