SPENT

THE MOTOR FUEL (DECONTROL) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)  
ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The following Orders are hereby revoked:-
  - (a) The Motor Fuel (Control) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, -1606 1949 dated 21st March, 1949, as amended;
  - (b) The Motor Fuel (Propane, Butane) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) -1464 Order, 1948, dated 18th March, 1948;
  - (c) The Motor Fuel (Standard Ration) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) -1636 Order, 1949, dated 6th May, 1949.
2. This Order may be cited as The Motor Fuel (Decontrol) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 27th day of May, 1950.
