The Export of Tomatoes (Zoning) No. 2. Order.

The States Committee for Horticulture, in pursuance of paragraph 5 of the Export of Tomatoes, 1950, No. 2 Order,^(a) hereby directs:-

1. The change of zones as regards permitted shipping days will take place during the week ending June 24th, 1950.
2. During the week ending June 24th, tomatoes packed in the Northern and Southern Zones will be shipped as follows:-

Monday, June 19th.	Southern Zone will ship.
Tuesday, June 20th.	Northern Zone will ship.
Wednesday, June 21st.	Southern Zone will ship.
Thursday, June 22nd.	Northern Zone will ship.
Friday, June 23rd.	Tomatoes packed in either of the two zones may be shipped.
Saturday, June 24th.	Southern Zone will ship.
3. The shipping days for the Zones from Saturday, June 24th, until further notice are therefore as follows:-

Southern Zone -	Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.
Northern Zone -	Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.
4. This Order shall not apply to growers and packers who, by arrangement with the Guernsey Tomato Shipping Board ship every day.
