THE FATS, CHEESE AND TEA (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF
GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, (a) shall be amended by substituting for the definition of cheese in Article 1 thereof the following definition:-

"'Cheese' means -

- (a) any cheese of the following varieties, whether home produced or imported, namely, Cheddar, Cheshire, Lancashire, Derbyshire, Leicestershire, White Wensleydale or Dunlop;
 - (b) any processed cheese, that is to say cheese which after manufacture has been heated and to which an emulsifying agent has been added, of the varieties set out in sub-paragraph (a) of this definition."
2. This Order may be cited as The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 2nd day of July, 1950.
