THE IMPORTED ANIMAL FEEDINGSTUFFS (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF
GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949 (a) shall be amended as follows:-
 - (a) by substituting for the definition of "Grain or pulse" in Article 1 thereof the following definition:-

"Grain" means barley, dredge corn, oats and wheat, but does not include any grain that has been subjected to any process other than one or more of the following - threshing, drying, cleaning, screening or dressing.";
 - (b) by deleting from Part A of the Schedule thereto the following entries:-

"Beans"
"Bean products"
"Peas"
"Pea products"
"Pea by-products";
 - (c) by substituting in Part A of the Schedule thereto for the entries "Dredge corn" and "Products of dredge corn" the entry "Dredge corn (other than dredge corn consisting solely of pulses) and products thereof";
2. This Order may be cited as The Imported Animal Feedingstuffs (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1950 and shall come into operation on the 4th day of July, 1950.
