THE UTILITY CLOTH AND UTILITY HOUSEHOLD TEXTILES
(MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 7) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949 (a), as amended (b), shall have effect subject to the following amendments:-
 - (a) in Part I of the First Schedule for the reference to Related Schedule No. 5H there shall be substituted a reference to Related Schedule No. 5J;
 - (b) in Section A of Part II of the First Schedule there shall be added the specification numbers 1043/1, 1043/2, 1044/1 and 1044/2;
 - (c) in Section B of Part II of the First Schedule there shall be added the specification number 1400;
 - (d) in the Second Schedule for the reference to Related Schedule No. 5H and Supplement No. 1 thereto there shall be substituted a reference to Related Schedule No. 5J, and for the reference to Related Schedule No. 6N and Supplements Nos. 1 and 2 thereto there shall be substituted a reference to Related Schedule No. 6N and Supplements Nos. 1, 2 and 3 thereto; and
 - (e) for the particulars in the Fourth Schedule there shall be substituted the particulars in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 7) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 14th day of July, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, which fixes retailers' maximum prices for utility cloth and utility household textiles by -

- (a) adding to the goods to which that Order applies rayon dress and blouse cloth of the specification Nos. 1043/1, 1043/2, 1044/1 and 1044/2, and one spun rayon pyjama cloth of the specification No. 1400, which have recently been introduced into the utility range;
- (b) fixing increased maximum prices for six descriptions of utility cotton quilt cloths included in the Fourth Schedule to the Principal Order; the increases are indicated by plus (+) signs in the Schedule to this Order;
- (c) bringing into force Related Schedule No. 5J (Utility Household Textiles) which replaces Related Schedule No. 5H and Supplement No. 1 thereto;
- (d) bringing into force Supplement No. 3 to Related Schedule No. 6N (Utility Upholstery Cloth and Utility Curtain Cloth).

The Related Schedules set out overriding maximum prices for the goods to which they relate.
