IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946.The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949,
Amendment No. 5 Order, 1950.

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of The Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

- (1) There shall be deleted from the Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated 3rd August, 1949, (a), the following item:-

"Poultry (dead or alive)".

- (2) There shall be deleted from the third paragraph of the Delegation of Power to Grant Export Licences (No.1) Order, 1949, dated 8th August, 1949 (b), the following item:-

"Poultry (dead or alive)".

- (3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

- (4) This Order shall come into force on the 27th day of July, 1950, and may be cited as the "Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 5 Order, 1950".

The effect of the above Order is that Poultry (dead or alive) may now be exported to the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick and the Isle of Man without restriction.
