THE BACON (PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT)
ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Bacon (Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (a), shall be amended as follows:-

(a) by adding after the word "person" in the first sentence of Article 2 thereof, the word "shall"; and

(b) by adding at the end of paragraph (1) of Article 3 thereof the following:-

"For the purposes of this paragraph the expression "buyers' premises" shall, in the case of a sale to Alderney be deemed to mean the port of loading in Guernsey."

2. This Order may be cited as The Bacon (Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1950, and shall come into force on the 24th day of July, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order, which amends The Bacon (Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 -

(a) corrects a typing error in Article 2; and

(b) provides that on sales by wholesale of bacon to Alderney the wholesaler shall be responsible for the costs of delivery only to the port of loading in Guernsey.
