THE MEAT PRODUCTS AND CANNED MEAT (CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 4) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Meat Products and Canned Meat (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended (a), shall be further amended as follows:-

- (1) by including "Imported quick-frozen meat meals" among the "Excepted Products" specified in Article 1 thereof;
- (2) by inserting in the said Article 1 thereof the following definition:-

"Imported Quick-frozen meat meal" means any open meat product as defined by this Order which has been imported in a frozen and cooked state."

- (3) by substituting for the definition of "Imported" in the said Article 1 thereof the following definition:-

"Imported" means imported into the Bailiwick of Guernsey from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man and the Channel Islands but does not include direct imports from France."

- (4) by adding the following proviso to the definition of "Meat product" contained in the said Article 1 thereof:-

"Provided that the use of fat of any meat as defined by this Order in the manufacture or preparation of any whale meat, vegetable or fish product, shall not be deemed to make that product a meat product";

- (5) by adding the following paragraph to Article 4 thereof:-

"(3) A person shall not use or cause to be used any whale meat in the preparation or manufacture by way of trade of any meat product";

- (6) by substituting for the items relating to meat roll or galantine, brawn of any kind, including potted head, haggis and meat paste in Part III of the Second Schedule thereto, the following items:-

- (3) The Meat Products and Canned Meat (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1949, dated 5th November, 1949 (d).

3. This Order may be cited as The Meat Products and Canned Meat (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 4) Order, 1950, and shall come into force on the 25th day of July, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order revokes and re-enacts in a consolidated form, the amendments to The Meat Products and Canned Meat (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949. It also amends the definition of "imported" to exclude specifically from the provisions of the Order, canned meats imported direct from France.
