GENERAL LICENCE DATED 2ND AUGUST, 1950, MADE BY THE STATES
OF GUERNSEY COMMITTEE FOR THE CONTROL OF ESSENTIAL
COMMODITIES UNDER THE SOAP (LICENSING OF MANUFACTURERS
AND RATIONING) (BAILLICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1950.

1. Pursuant to Article 22 of The Soap (Licensing of Manufacturers and Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (a) the States of Guernsey Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities hereby authorises any person (herein referred to as the "supplier") to supply, free from the provisions of Article 7 of that Order, to any trader for sale or resale by him any quantity of soap remaining at the disposal of the supplier after reserving quantities sufficient to satisfy in full orders in respect of Ration Periods Nos. 3 or 4 received by him on valid Order Forms S.P.3 or for delivery against valid Buying Permits S.P.4; and any such trader is hereby authorised so to obtain for sale or resale by him any soap supplied in accordance with the foregoing.
2. This Licence shall come into operation on the 13th day of August, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Licence but is intended
to indicate its general purport).

This Licence permits the supply to wholesalers and retailers of additional quantities of soap free of rationing requirements in readiness for derationing on the 10th September, 1950.
