THE GENERAL FOOD (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF
GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (a) shall be amended as follows:-
 - (a) by deleting from Part III - Dried Fruit, of the Schedule thereto the entries relating to Unstoned Dates, other than Dates of African origin and Stoned Dates, other than Dates of African origin; and
 - (b) by adding at the end of the said Schedule as Part XI - Table Jellies, the part so numbered in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1950, and shall come into force on the 2nd day of August, 1950.

THE SCHEDULE.

Part XI - Table Jellies.

<u>Description.</u>	<u>Container.</u>	<u>Maximum Retail Price per packet.</u>
Table jelly compounds.	1 pint packet (containing not less than 2½ oz. net weight).	s. d. 7
Table jelly tablets.	1 pint packet (containing not less than 5 oz. net weight).	8½
Table jelly crystals.	1 pint packet (containing not less than 3 oz. net weight).	6½
Table jelly crystals.	1 pint packet (containing not less than ¾ oz. net weight).	7½

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order, which amends The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, removes from price control both stoned and unstoned dates, other than dates of African origin and prescribes maximum retail prices for table jellies.
