THE EXPORT OF OUTDOOR TOMATOES (NO. 2) ORDER, 1950.

The States Committee for Horticulture, under and by virtue of "The Export of Tomatoes Law, 1949", as extended by "The Export of Tomatoes Law, 1949, (Continuance) Law, 1949", for the purpose of ensuring the orderly and expeditious marketing of tomatoes from Guernsey in 1950, hereby orders:-

1. No vehicle containing outdoor-grown tomatoes will be permitted on the export line until the driver thereof has presented the contents of the vehicle for inspection at the office of the Inspector of Produce, situated in the store of the Fruit Export Co. Ltd., St. Julian's Emplacement, and obtained a clearance ticket denoting that the contents of the vehicle have been passed as fit for export.
2. This Order will become operative on Tuesday, the 29th day of August, 1950.
