THE UTILITY APPAREL (MAXIMUM PRICES AND CHARGES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 11) ORDER, 1950.See S.I. 111 (1950)

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended (a), shall have effect subject to the following amendments to the Table set out in paragraph (1) of Article 6 thereof:-
 - (a) for the reference to Related Schedule No. 3F and Supplements Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 thereto there shall be substituted a reference to Related Schedule No. 3G;
 - (b) for the reference to Related Schedule No. 5F there shall be substituted a reference to Related Schedule No. 5G;
 - (c) the reference to infants' and girls' apparel (other than knitted apparel and gloves) and to Related Schedule No. 7C and Supplements Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 thereto shall be omitted; and
 - (d) for the reference to Related Schedule No. 17 there shall be substituted a reference to Related Schedule No. 17 and Supplement No. 1 thereto.
2. This Order may be cited as The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 11) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 22nd day of August, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, which fixes retailers' maximum prices for utility apparel by -

- (a) substituting Related Schedule No. 3G (women's and maids' outerwear other than knitted apparel and gloves) for Related Schedule No. 5F and Supplements Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 thereto;
- (b) substituting Related Schedule No. 5G (industrial overalls and aprons) for Related Schedule No. 5F;
- (c) bringing into force Supplement No. 1 to Related Schedule No. 17 (women's domestic overalls and aprons);
- (d) omitting the reference to Related Schedule No. 7C and Supplements Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 thereto (infants' and girls' apparel other than knitted apparel and gloves).

These Related Schedules provide retailers overriding maximum prices for the garments to which they relate. The omission of the reference to Related Schedule No. 7C and its Supplements means that the maximum price of infants' utility apparel, other than knitted apparel and gloves, is now to be computed by reference solely to the purchase price paid and the permitted margin. The nature of the changes made by the introduction of the new Related Schedules and Supplement is indicated in the Explanatory Notes issued with them.
