THE UTILITY APPAREL (MAXIMUM PRICES AND CHARGES)  
(BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 12)  
ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended (a) shall have effect subject to the amendment that in the Table set out in paragraph (1) of Article 6 thereof for the reference to Related Schedule No. 1J there shall be substituted a reference to Related Schedule No. 1J and Supplement No. 1 thereto.
2. This Order may be cited as The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 12) Order, 1950, and shall come into force on the 1st day of September, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, by bringing into force Supplement No. 1 to Related Schedule No. 1J. That Schedule contains retailers' over-riding maximum prices for men's, youths' and boys' utility outerwear (other than knitted apparel and gloves).
