THE UTILITY CLOTH AND UTILITY HOUSEHOLD TEXTILES (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (a) shall be amended as follows:-
 - (1) in Item 9 of the First Schedule thereto there shall be added after the word "bedding" the words "or utility quilt cloths";
 - (2) in Item 11 of the said First Schedule for the words "specified in Part II of Related Schedule No. 6N" there shall be substituted the following "of a specification number set out in Section C of Part II of this Schedule";
 - (3) in Item 12 of the said First Schedule for the words "specified in Part III of Related Schedule No. 6N" there shall be substituted the following "of a specification number set out in Section D of Part II of this Schedule";
 - (4) there shall be added after Section B of Part II of the said First Schedule as Sections C and D the Sections so described in the First Schedule hereto;
 - (5) in the Second Schedule thereto for the reference to Related Schedule No. 5J and Supplement No. 1 thereto there shall be substituted a reference to Related Schedule No. 5J and Supplement Nos. 1 and 2 thereto;
 - (6) there shall be deleted from the said Second Schedule the references to utility upholstery cloth and utility curtain cloth and to Related Schedule No. 6N and Supplements Nos. 1, 2 and 3 thereto;
 - (7) for the Fourth Schedule thereto there shall be substituted the Second Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1950, and shall come into force on the 18th day of September, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends the Order which fixes retailers' maximum prices for utility cloth and utility household textiles, by -

- (a) bringing into force Supplement No. 2 to Related Schedule No. 5J which sets out retailers' overriding maximum prices for utility household textiles;
- (b) providing that maximum prices for utility upholstery cloth and utility curtain cloth are now to be computed solely by reference to the purchase price paid and the permitted margin. The reference to Related Schedule No. 6N and Supplements Nos. 1, 2 and 3 thereto, which provide overriding maximum prices for these goods, is now omitted from the Second Schedule to the Order; and
- (c) fixing increased maximum prices for seven descriptions of utility cotton quilt cloths included in the Fourth Schedule to the principal Order; the increases are indicated by plus (+) signs in the Second Schedule to this Order.
