THE MEAT (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 4)
ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (a) as amended (b), shall be further amended by substituting for paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Schedule thereto (which specifies the amount of the meat ration) the following paragraphs:-

"1. Amount against the appropriate coupons relating to each week in a -

General Ration Book R.B.1	}	1s. 7d. maximum price (9½d. maximum retail price for each coupon) or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey 3s. 0d. maximum price (1s. 6d. maximum retail price for each coupon).
Junior Ration Book R.B.4		
Form R.B.12		

2. Amount against each appropriate coupon in a -

Child's Ration Book R.B.2	}	9½d. maximum retail price or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey 1s. 6d. maximum retail price."
Ration Book R.B.7		
Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A		

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in Article 1 of this Order, the maximum quantity of meat which may be obtained or supplied against an appropriate coupon for meat in any of the ration documents mentioned in Article 1 relating to the week beginning 8th October, 1950, and valid for use during the said week and the following week, but not used during the said week beginning 8th October, 1950, shall be the maximum retail price applicable in relation thereto immediately prior to the coming into operation of this Order.

3. This Order may be cited as The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 4) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 15th day of October, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order reduces, as from the 15th October, 1950, the amount of the meat ration which may be obtained against appropriate coupons in Ration Books R.B.1 and R.B.4 and Form R.B.12 from 1s. 8d. to 1s. 7d. maximum retail price, except where locally produced pork is supplied in which case the appropriate coupons remain valid for 3s. 0d. maximum retail price. The value of appropriate coupons in the Child's Ration Book R.B.2, Ration Book R.B.7 and Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A is reduced from 10d. to 9½d. but where locally produced pork is supplied the value of such coupons remains at 1s. 6d.

Coupons valid for use during the week beginning 8th October, 1950, and the following week but not used in the week beginning 8th October, 1950, remain valid, if used in the week beginning 15th October, 1950, for the maximum retail price applicable in relation thereto immediately prior to this Order coming into operation.
