THE BACON (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT  
NO. 3) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950 (a) as amended (b) shall be further amended by substituting in the Second Column of the Schedule thereto (which specifies the amount of the bacon ration) for the amount "4 oz." in relation to each appropriate coupon in a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Junior Ration Book R.B.4, a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 and a Form R.B.12 the amount "3 oz."
2. Notwithstanding anything contained in Article 1 of this Order, the maximum amount of bacon which may be obtained or supplied against an appropriate coupon for bacon in any of the ration documents mentioned in Article 1 of this Order relating to the week beginning 15th October, 1950, and valid for use during the said week and the following week, but not used during the said week beginning 15th October, 1950, shall be 4 oz. net.
3. This Order may be cited as The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 22nd day of October, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order, as from 22nd October, 1950, reduces by 1 oz. per week, to 3 ozs., the amount of the bacon ration which may be obtained on a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Junior Ration Book R.B.4, a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 and a Form R.B.12. Appropriate coupons in these ration documents valid for use during the week beginning 15th October, 1950, and the following week, but not used in the week beginning 15th October, 1950, remain valid, if used in the week beginning 22nd October, 1950, for 4 ozs.
