IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946.

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949.

AMENDMENT NO. 6 ORDER, 1950.

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The Second Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a), shall be amended by the deletion therefrom of the item -
"Household furniture, that is to say, any article of furniture commonly used for domestic purposes"
and by the addition thereto of the following item -
"Carpets, rugs and mats of every description".
2. The Delegation of Power to Grant Export Licences (No. 1) Order, 1949, (b), shall be amended by substituting for the item "Household furniture" the item "Carpets, rugs and mats".
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Order, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into force on the 20th day of November, 1950, and may be cited as the "Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 6 Order, 1950".

The effect of the above Order is that from the 20th November, 1950, household furniture other than carpets, rugs and mats may be exported without restriction to the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other Islands of this Bailiwick and the Isle of Man.
