THE FOOD (LICENSING OF WHOLESALERS) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)  
(AMENDMENT NO. 4) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Food (Licensing of Wholesalers) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, as amended (a) shall be further amended by deleting from the Schedule thereto the following items, "Biscuits, rusks and crispbreads", "Canned fish", "Canned fruit", "Dried fruits", "Rice", "Table Jellies".
2. This Order may be cited as The Food (Licensing of Wholesalers) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 4) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 18th day of November, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amending The Food (Licensing of Wholesalers) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, abolishes the necessity for a licence for a sale by wholesale of biscuits, rusks and crispbreads, canned fish, canned fruit, dried fruits, rice and table jellies.
